

Minutes for City of Conesville Regular Meeting April 11th 2022

Meeting called to order at 6:37pm

Present were Mayor Herb Gartzke, Council members: Michael Sypherd, Cory Conaway, Rick McMeekan, Kelly Singleton, Police chief David Perley, and sewer maintainer Austin Conaway, stand in clerk Kasandra Sypherd.

Ron Oveson of Oveson Refuse presented a contract to the city regarding supplying the citizens with trash containers if the city agrees to lock in a five year contract at a set price. City council discussed options and rather they thought citizens would prefer to have cotainers. No decision was made at this time.

Motion to approve March 14th regular meeting minutes by K. Singleton seconded by M. Sypherd.

Motion to approve March 28th special meeting minutes by K. Singleton seconded by M. Sypherd.

Police report given by D. Perley. Some discussion about signs needing changed for road signs to include North and South and getting a quote for a building sign that says 'City Hall'. Motion to approve Police report by K. Singleton, seconded by R. McMeekan.

Sewer report given by Austin Conaway. Locks had been tampered with at lagoon access. Discussion on cost of a natural gas generator to be added, lift station wiring needing updated as well. Total cost of project could be \$45 thousand. Funding could be covered by Covid relief funds or other grants. Motion to approve sewer report by K. Singleton, seconded by C. Conaway.

Clerks report given by Kasandra Sypherd. Clerkbooks personnel will be at City Hall next week to begin set-up. Warrants list and revenue reported. Motion to approve by K. Singleton, seconded by R. McMeekan.

City council asked for any interest in the vacant council seat, one person was interested and was appointed by council. Fifth seat is now occupied by Azure Conaway.

City had posted City Clerk position for the minimum 30 days required. One application was submitted. Patrice Caux was hired via roll call vote to fill the position.

Mayor Herb Gartzke reported that Danny Conaway and himself drove around town inspecting road conditions. There was only a small section that needs work and we will obtain a quote from LL Pelling.

Discussion on rather or not to put out speed bumps or not. They were ineffective in the past but speeding on side streets is an ongoing issue.
